### : RESOLUTIONS :

**The following matters were discussed and resolutions adopted:**

**Resolution No. 1:** Matters relating to non-submission of case diaries by the Investigating Officers in respect of consideration of bail prayer of the accused persons on time were discussed. Generally, in the District of Bongaigaon, the Investigating Officers send the case diaries to the Courts in the afternoon hours on the date fixed for submission of case diaries. In such a situation, when the Sessions Judge takes up the bail matters on 10:30 A.M., submission of case diaries in the afternoon hours on the date fixed causes hindrance in disposal of the bail matters. Therefore, it was resolved that the Additional Superintendent of Police, Bongaigaon representing the S.P. Bongaigaon would ensure that the case diaries are sent by the Investigating Officers to the Courts prior to one day or before 10:30 A.M. on the date fixed for submission of case diaries and the concerned Investigating Officers be instructed accordingly.

**Resolution No. 2:** Matters relating to non-submission of reports on summons and Warrant of Arrest issued against the accused persons by the Officers-in-charge of the concerned police stations on time were discussed.

Generally, in the District of Bongaigaon, the Officers-in-charge of the concerned police stations send the reports on summons and Warrant of Arrest to the Courts in the afternoon hours on the date fixed for submission of case diaries. In such a situation, when the Courts in the afternoon hours on the date fixed causes hindrance in passing order. Therefore, it was resolved that the Additional superintendent of Police, Bongaigaon representing the S.P. Bongaigaon would ensure that the reports on summons and warrant of Arrest are sent by the Officer-in-Charge of the concerned police stations to the Courts prior to one day of the date fixed for submission of reports on summons and Warrant of Arrest and the concerned Officers-in-charge of the concerned police stations be instructed accordingly.

The matters of this meeting has further resolved to send copies of the minutes of this meeting to the Registrar (Judicial), Gauhati High Court, Guwahti for information and the following authorities for information and necessary action.
