1) **AGENDA No-1: Crime review Meeting organised by the Superintendent of Police, Bongaigaon**

The instant matter was taken up for discussion and the District & Sessions Judge has requested the Superintendent of Police, Bongaigaon to share the discussions taken up in the Crime Review Meeting organised by the Superintendent of Police, Bongaigaon.

After discussion, it was agreed by all present that the Superintendent of Police, Bongaigaon would take up the matter and also point out the areas which can be taken up for discussion for better coordination amongst the various stake holders and the problems faced by all.

2) **AGENDA No-2: Discussion of the judgment passed in Thane Singh vs Central Bureau of Narcotics ( (2013) 2 SCC 603:**

In the meeting, the issue as regards trial and bail in cases under the NDPS Act was discussed and the Sessions Judge, Bongaigaon placed on record the judgment passed

has been pointed out that in some cases, proper procedure is not being followed in cases under the NDPS Act by the investigation, prosecuting agencies and even by the trial courts. In this regard, it has been informed by the Superintendent of Police that they will take up this matter for discussion with all the police officers in the crime review meeting to be held soon.

**3) AGENDA No-3: : Non Execution of Processes and Orders of the Courts:**

It has been brought to the notice of the all the members present by the District & Sessions Judge that in some cases, the I.O.s and the M.O. fail to act as per the orders of the court and accordingly, has placed on record the coercive measures that can be initiated for not following the orders of the court.

The District Judge has urged the Superintendent of Police to take up the matter and sensitize the Police Officials under his jurisdiction the need to ensure that the orders of the court are followed and also pointed out the relevant sections of law that the Police Officials may be made aware of. .


